#### **Serra International**

Serra International has special recognition from the Vatican – it is aggregated to the Pontifical Work for Vocations to the Priesthood within the Sacred Congregation for the Clergy. Almost 1,100 Serra Clubs have been chartered in 44 Countries since the formation of Serra in the Unites States of America in 1935. Membership of Serra exceeds 15,000 and is open to Catholic laymen, laywomen and Permanent Deacons. Serra is named after Father ("Fray") Junipero Serra, the noted Spanish Franciscan missionary priest who played a leading part in early missionary work in Mexico and California.
