Easter is an invitation to live with Hope: *Shalom*- Peace

The darkness of passion and death is transformed by the hope and triumph of empty tomb and the resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. In this ‘**year of the Holy Spirit**’ in our Archdiocese and ‘**the year of prayer**’ in the universal church, in preparation the 2025 jubilee year, we are reminded to encounter that hope and peace, Easter brings to us.

‘*Shalom*’ is what God offers to each one of us and we need to share the same with our brothers and sisters. We are travelling through a period of chaos in our world and may be in our personal and family life. This Easter, each of us can bring the power of Christ’s Resurrection into our world by standing against the powers of oppression and fear.

Through our continual dying and rising in Christ, let us meet Christ in ourselves, others and in our surroundings, the sidelined, marginalized, lonely, abandoned, the refugees and the homeless. Let us develop the courage and boldness to deepen our faith and to express it in our words and deeds. During this Easter season may you be blessed with the newness, peace and joy of the Risen Lord.
