

Corpus Christi Parish Vinnies 2024 Winter Appeal and food drive May 18-19

As housing security becomes more precarious due to rising rents, cost-of-living pressures and a shortage

of affordable housing, our services are hearing daily from people who in years gone by would never have needed to seek support. These are people who hold jobs that should offer stability, yet are sleeping in cars, tents or relying on the goodwill of others. Funds raised through the Winter Appeal will be used to fund our core programs including supporting people experiencing or at risk of homelessness, and people struggling with poverty and cost-of-living pressures. You can support the work of the Society and help our companions rebuild their lives by giving generously to the Winter Appeal. There will be envelopes available at the church for you to make your donations anytime throughout the appeal, but **the weekend of May 18/19 has been designated for** the parish appeal. Our volunteers will be available before and after all masses to collect your donations (cash or EFTPOS) and to discuss our conference work.
