Vinnies Winter Appeal Thank You

The Calwell and Gowrie Conference volunteers would like to offer our sincere thanks to our fellow Corpus Christi parishioners who donated so generously to last weekend's annual Parish Vinnies Winter Appeal.

Nearly 40,000 people in Canberra are living below the poverty line. Not only has the Consumer Price Index (CPI) in the ACT increased at a higher rate than nationally, but the ACT is also home to the second-highest median rent prices after Sydney. During these tough economic times, Society members continue to provide emergency financial and material assistance to people in need, including food parcels, assistance with energy bills and provision of household items. Your generous cash and food donations will be used to fund our core programs including supporting people experiencing or at risk of homelessness, and people struggling with poverty and cost-of-living pressures.

The Vinnies Winter Appeal continues until August, so if you haven't yet donated and would like to, you can collect an envelope from the church foyer. There are also empty tubs in the foyer into which you can place any "winter warmer" food donations.
