#### **Eucharist Formation Sessions for Parents/Carers**

This session is a compulsory component of the program even if you have had children go through the program in previous years you are expected to attend. The sessions are designed for adult learning and formation, giving new insights into reflections on the Eucharist. You need to attend **one** of these sessions:

Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> July, Session 2 **Time: 5.30pm-6.30pm**

More detailed information regarding First Eucharist will be shared at this meeting as well. You will also be given your child's sacramental stole at the conclusion of the meeting.

#### **Eucharist Commitment Masses**

You are required to present your child to the parish community as a candidate for First Eucharist by attending **one** of the eight weekend Masses below. Commitment Forms and Prayer Cards will be given out at the Parent Formation Night.

Sunday at 8.00am; 10.00am OR 6.00pm

- Saturday/Sunday 3 August & 4 August
- Saturday/Sunday 10 August & 11 August

Please fill in the Commitment Form and **BRING IT WITH YOU** to the Mass. A copy can be found at the back of this booklet. Your child will need to bring their Prayer Cards as well. The children can hand these out to parishioners in the foyer after Mass, saying "Please pray for me."

#### **Eucharist Home Sessions**

Parents and Carers will be required to work through four prayer activity sessions with their child over a period of four weeks. The sessions form the core of the parental preparation of their children for their First Communion. Each session is meant to be 30 minutes long, starting with a reflection, an activity and a prayer.

The Home Sessions will be sent out by email from the Parish Office on: Friday 9 August (Term 3, Week 3) - Jesus said, "I am the Bread of Life" Friday 16 August (Term 3, Week 4)- Stole making session – "Putting On Christ" Friday 23 August (Term 3, Week 5)- Actions & Gestures used at Mass Friday 30 August (Term 3, Week 6)- "Lord I am not worthy" – Rite of the Mass.

First Eucharist Masses will be celebrated over three weekends at the Saturday 6.00pm Mass and the Sunday 8.00am, 10.00am and 6.00pm parish Masses. # Online bookings via Qkr! will open on MONDAY 5<sup>th</sup> AUGUST and close FRIDAY 16<sup>th</sup> AUGUST,

Parents are responsible for their child's stole. You will need to bring it with you to Mass. A basket will be provided in the foyer of the Church for you to hand back your child's stole after Mass.

#### What should the First Communicant wear?

All children will be wearing the stole they have prepared.

You may choose what your child wears. The 'outfit' should be neat and tidy and respectfully suitable for the occasion. Tops with visible 'logos' should be avoided. Your child's choice of footwear should not hinder them from easily walking around the Church (e.g. avoid very high heels).

Please ensure that your child brings their sacramental stole to the church and wears it during the Mass.

## What about photos?

No photos or videos are to be taken during the sacred celebration of the Mass. There will be opportunity for you to take your individual photos after Mass. Fr James & Fr Namora will be available for individual photos with your child.

## What gifts can be given?
