New Memorial Wall at HFC

The Columbarium’s built around the Holy Family church which is closer to the altar is a beautiful image of the heaven meeting the earth. Each time we celebrate the Holy Eucharist or engage in any form of prayers, it is an image that reminds those celebrating Mass or praying, that their loved ones, who is in the presence of God, are close and are praying together.

As per the original design, the Holy Family church is to have columbarium walls on three sides of the church. As currently is, we have completed building two walls and now we are in the process of building the third and final wall. You will notice some work activities going in the church and please be aware that the access to the work area is restricted.

The total cost of this project is around \$20 thousand and if anyone would like to support this project financially, you are most welcome to contribute through our parish account. Contributing to the project does not bring any automatic claim of spaces/reservations in the wall.

2024 Series of Guinness & God happening next Wednesday 14 August from 6:30pm – 8:30pm at King O’Malley’s Pub in the city. **Speaker: Captain Gavin Keating on the topic Faith Under Fire.**

For over fifteen years, Guinness and God has offered a space for young adults, university students and young professionals to gather in the very heart of Canberra city to open up conversations around life and faith. The format for each gathering is simple: gather with friends over dinner and drinks before hearing from a guest speaker which is followed by an opportunity to ask questions and seek new perspectives.

Over the years we have engaged Australian church leaders, political figures, professional athletes, diplomats, media personalities and justice advocates.

About our Speaker: Gavin Keating had a long career as an infantry officer in the Australian Army and reached the rank of Colonel. He served in the 2nd Battalion, Royal Australian Regiment, Special Air Service Regiment and the 3rd Battalion, Royal Australian Regiment and has been deployed on operations to East Timor, Bougainville, Afghanistan, Iraq, the Middle East, and Indonesia. **Gavin completed his 2 year pastoral placement at Corpus Christi Parish (2021-2022) and was ordained at Holy Family Church Gowrie in July 2022 by Archbishop Prowse as a Permanent Deacon for the Military Ordinariate of Australia.** Gavin is currently serving full-time as a Chaplain at the Royal Military College, Duntroon.
