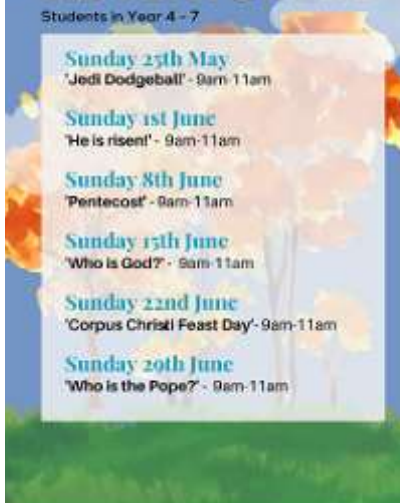
Letters of concern
