Canberra Hospitals and Parishioners.


The Archdiocese allocates clergy chaplains to visit our beloved parishioners in hospital. The parishes pay (i.e., your planned giving) for this. Local clergy can then follow-up at home if requested. Due to ACT Government regulations spiritual care staff or clergy can only visit if they receive a specific request from the patient, their immediate family, or hospital staff on that ward. If your loved one is in hospital and wants a visit from the spiritual care person or chaplain, please have them make that request via the Hospital Pastoral Care Team. **We don't wish to sound like we don't care, but confusion with this can lead over-visiting some people and then missing others.** Thankyou.
