It is with deep sadness, that we announce the sudden passing of Fr Troy Bobbin, Parish Priest of Holy Spirit Parish, Amaroo, ACT. Fr Troy died peacefully at Canberra Hospital on 7 July 2026.



He was born in Boorowa and educated at St Patrick's, Boorowa, Latham Primary School and St Francis Xavier College, Florey ACT. Answering his call to priesthood, Fr Troy entered St Paul's Seminary, NSW and was ordained a Deacon on 27 October 1995. He was ordained to the Priesthood in 1996.

Over the course of his ministry, Fr Troy served faithfully in the parishes of Young, Calwell ACT, Ardlethan and Barellan, West Wyalong and West Wyalong Mission, Queanbeyan, and Gungahlin ACT.

His pastoral care, warmth, and unwavering dedication touched countless lives, and his presence will be deeply missed by parishioners, colleagues, and friends alike.

May Christ, the Good Shepherd, welcome him into eternal rest, and may his soul find peace in the presence of the Lord he served so well.
